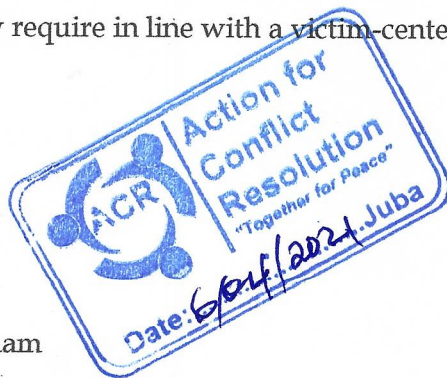




Action for Conflict Resolution (ACR) Adopted the United Nations policy on Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA) as the safeguarding principle to the organization's operations in protecting human rights, the document has been signed by the board of directors and implemented by senior management.

Key points

- No staff of Action for Conflict Resolution (ACR) should engage in sexual exploitation and abuse and any suspicion of sexual exploitation or abuse towards beneficiaries' / individuals should immediately be reported to focal person concerned of (ACR).
- ACR will provide an environment free from SEA, by creating awareness on their rights, services and where / how to access them, that sexual exploitation is not tolerated, and how they can report any concerns.
- ACR Safeguard that effective, safe, and accessible feedback and response mechanisms are in place to report any suspicions of SEA.
- Systematically integrated PSEA in information campaigns, awareness-raising, trainings and meetings with the beneficiaries.
- ACR will ensure that victims of SEA have access without delay to the assistance and support that they require in line with a victim-centered approach.
